Treasurer:

We started August with \$3,692.04 in the bank. District monthly expenses totaled \$877.63 and consisted of \$537.00 for a 3 year Grapevine subscription for CI Committee, \$80.63 for the Verizon bill, \$60.00 for District Meeting room rent, and \$200.00 to Rule 62 Clubhouse for archive storage. Pink Can had \$299.10 in expenses for Grapevines for Clinton Co and Living Sober books for CCCF. We had \$138.00 in 7th Tradition contributions and \$174.00 in Pink Can contributions. The District's available funds at month end (above prudent reserve) are \$1,484.51, and the Pink Can available funds are \$142.80. August ending balance, including the prudent reserve, was \$2,827.3. Motion to approve the June financial report passed unanimously.
