Motion to approve the November minutes passed unanimously.

Treasurer:

We started November with \$3,498.48 in the bank. District monthly expenses totaled \$304.57 and consisted of \$225.00 to Centre Helps and \$79.57 for the Verizon bill. Pink Can had no expenses in November. We had \$145.00 in 7th Tradition contributions and \$147.00 in Pink Can contributions. The District's available funds at month end (above prudent reserve) are \$1,541.61, and the Pink Can available funds are \$744.30. November ending bank balance, including the prudent reserve, was \$3,485.91.
