Treasurer:

We started December with \$3,485.91 in the bank. District monthly expenses totaled \$78.85 for the Verizon bill. Pink Can spent \$720.61 for Grapevines and a variety of books for Clinton and The Meadows. We had \$591.00 in 7th Tradition contributions and \$65.00 in Pink Can contributions. The District's available funds at month end (above prudent reserve) are \$2,053.76, and the Pink Can available funds are \$88.69. December ending bank balance, including the prudent reserve, was \$3,342.45.
