Treasurer:

We started January with \$3,342.45 in the bank. District monthly expenses totaled \$375.24 for the Verizon bill, \$225.00 to Centre Helps for the hotline quarterly payment, and \$71.67 in subcommittee expenses. Pink Can spent \$182.50 for Grapevines for CCCF. We had \$313.95 in 7th Tradition contributions and \$396.75 in Pink Can contributions.
