Treasurer:

We started February with \$3,495.41 in the bank. District monthly expenses totaled \$429.00; \$76.28 to Verizon, \$292.72 to GoDaddy for website hosting and domain name, and \$60.00 in District Meeting rent. Pink Can spent \$526.97; \$232.14 for Plain Language Big Books for CCCF, and \$294.83 to replenish books on hand. We had \$624.50 in 7th Tradition contributions and \$452.00 in Pink Can contributions. The District's available funds at month end (above prudent reserve) are \$2,187.97, and the Pink Can available funds are \$227.97. February ending bank balance, including the prudent reserve, was \$3,615.94.
